


SIDNEY MYER MUSIC BOWL MELBOURNE AUSTRALIA

The Sidney Myer Music Bowl was built in 1959. In May 2000 the supporting cables for the roof structure were “Zinganised” to extend the design life. The preparation was a high pressure water blast with limestone injection, supplemented by hand preparation methods where necessary. The Zinga application was a single coat resulting in a DFT of 60µm, with special attention to working the Zinga into crevices of the cables. These photos were taken during a site visit in July 2009. They demonstrate the ability of Zinga to work on a flexible structure and the lack of undercreep where damaged.
